

Basmah Emergency Food Aid for 300 Families Affected by Cyclone Amphan in Koira, Khulna District

A decade's strong cyclone-Amphan hid hard Koira destroying the entire area and forcing people to leave their land and take shelter on embankments. Life in this coastline areas almost has become standstill. People are in dire need of food and essential commodities. Basmah has reached there with emergency aid to help out the people and distributed aid among 300 families that included food and other supplies that would last for several days. Basmah volunteer team has done a great job in reaching out there and distributing the aid.



Basmah's Regular Medical Care Service for Rohingya Refugees at the Camp in Teknaf

Basmah is providing regular free treatment and medicines to the Rohingya refugees at the medical center. Alhandulillah a full, dedicated medical team with doctor, assistants and staff are serving the refugees everyday at the Basmah medical center which remains open from morning till evening. The medical center also provides health awareness, masks and other support to help prevent diseases and coronavirus at the camp. Basmah's New School in Nunertek

Sayedabad in Nunertek is a remote island surrounded by rivers and wetland. The people in this island are devoid of many basic necessities including a school for the children. A new school has been established here by Basmah and the children are so happy receiving the new school uniform, books, pencils and warm care provided by Basmah staff at the school. BASMAH Cooked Food Distribution in October 2020



Basmah began with a different arrangement of cooked food distribution by giving food at the Orphanage in October. Basmah makes its effort to bring nutritious, cooked food at the doorsteps of the children and their families living in slums, the homeless and street people in different parts of the city. In the month of October alone Basmah has distributed cooked food many in areas including Mohammadpur, Vatara, Kamrangir Char, Gulistan, Chankherpul areas. Basmah remains beside the hungry and poor people who can not arrange a proper meal for themselves.



House Reconstruction Project Launched by Basmah in Khulna Region



Basmah Foundation has begun the reconstruction of houses affected by devastating cyclone Amphan in Khulna region from 25 October 2020. A huge number of people were affected by the cyclone losing their homes, farms, cattle and took shelter in the embankment for survival. Basmah Foundation is providing clean water provision by installing tube wells and toilets for people in these areas. With the Basmah Foundation's reconstruction effort, clean water and toilet provisions, these helpless people are seeing the hope of returning to their houses for the temporary shelter in

embankment. Basmah Foundation also distributed emergency food aid among these people earlier.



Employment Program for the Poor and Widowed Women by Basmah

Basmah Foundation has been working to create opportunities for self-employment for the poor and widowed women for quite some time. Basmah Foundation has begun the initiative through skill training of women of tailoring and sewing of garments. The initiative is running very effectively and already in Lalmonirhat, Kurigram, Dinajpur, Siranjong and Teknaf areas the program has been successfully completed. At present the program is continuing in Rohingya Refugee camp and in Mymensingh.



Basmah Among the Flood Victims in Gaibandha District

The widespread flooding has not completely ceased in Bangladesh. Every now and then new areas are becoming inundated in different parts in Bangladesh. The Gaibandha district has been particularly affected this year with all of its Upazilas being flooded. Tens of thousands of people have been affected due to this flooding. The people are still living with the flood water that destroyed their homes, farmlands, cattle, businesses, marketplace and the rural infrastructure. Food crisis, scarcity of clean water and lack of toilets and other basic necessities have been

acute as people try to take shelter on any highland they find. Basmah Foundation has rushed to these areas with emergency food aid. The area is not easily reachable as boat is the only transportation to reach the furthest points in remote areas. Basmah Foundation team arrived in the spots in the evening overcoming the hurdles of the inaccessibility. Alhandulillah, even at the evening, Basmah Foundation has distributed food aid and necessary items among 1,000 flood victim families there. This assistance is not adequate given the magnitude of the crisis, nonetheless Basmah Foundation continues to make its effort to help these people as much as possible.

The CEO of the Foundation Mr. Meer S Hossain describes this as a visionary program that has the potential of creating self-employments for the young graduates and showing them a path for small enterprise, beginning with small, innovative schemes towards a successful life.

Sonargaon is a thana under Narayanganj district which has been hit hard by the Covid-19 led situation.
