BASMAH has distributed food aid among 720 poor families in the remote underprivileged area- Syedabad-Roghunathchar in Narayanganj on 23 Sep 2020.



While Narayanganj district flourishes, its peripheral area Nunertek which lies with the bank of river Meghna is still lagging behind. The people here are very poor and basic services like education, medical care and essential facilities hardly exist in the area. The

remoteness of the area is one of the reasons for the falling behind in development. Basmah has come forward to help develop the area. Basmah has distributed food to poor and disadvantaged families living in this island who are suffering from poverty and food crisis.

Basmah Supports to Prevent Coronavirus Spread in Narayangonj



The covid-19 danger is still looming over, Basmah has provided protective equipment & items (PPE) to help prevent the spread of coronavirus in Narayangonj. Basmah team has handed over the PPE and other items to Mr. Liyakat Hossain Khoka, the honorable Member of Parliament (MP) of Sonargaon, in Narayngonj district on 16 September 2020. These PPE will be distributed among front-line workers and volunteers who are providing service to the people. This will especially help the workers and volunteers assisting the victims of the recent fatal incident of AC blast in the Masjid in Narayngonj which have killed over 30 people. BASMAH also continues to providing food aid among the poor families in the area.



Basmah Food Aid for the Disadvantaged People in Jumpur, Narayangonj



Jumpur- an underdeveloped area in Sonargaon Upazilla in Narayangonj district. People here are very poor, the huts and mud-houses symbolize the impoverish condition of the life and economy. Many poor families are struggling to arrange food and the coronavirus situation has made it even worse. Basmah has come forward to help the poor families here with food aid. Alhamdulillah

on 02 October, food aid has been distributed among 1100 poor families in Jumpur. Also in the recent time about 550 families were provided with food aid in this area by Basmah. Basmah envisage a prosperous Jamalpur and would like to see the end of sufferings of the people here.

Food aid have been distributed among the poor and destitute families in Syedabad which is a remote island area in Narayangonj district crisscrossed by river Meghna and wetlands. BASMAH Women Empowerment Project- Sewing Machine Training Center Opened

BASMAH Foundation has inaugurated its women empowerment project. The project aims to provide skill training to refugee women mainly on sewing and tailoring so that these women can engage into income earning and start small scale entrepreneurship to support their families. BASMAH Foundation also provides them with advice on market linkage and small capitals to do something on their own. Through this initiative women are expected to be empowered to do something independently on their own.



Free Sanitary napkin Distribution in Sirajgonj and Lalmonirhat Districts

Basmah has distributed free sanitary napkins among young girls and women to raise their awareness on good health and hygiene practice. Basmah believes that if a mother is safe and healthy, the entire generation from her is going to be safe and healthy. Menstruation and menstrual practices still face many social, cultural, and religious restrictions which are a big barrier in the path of the menstrual hygiene management. Also the lack of knowledge about remaining safe during menstruation is a big concern in our country. Basmah plans to work for the sake of the mother's health and to change society's outlook. With this end in view free napkins were distributed in Sirajgonj on 12 Sep and in Lalmonirhat on 27 Sep 2020.



BASMAH Continues Distributing Cooked Food for Hungry Children



BASMAH reaches the hard to reach- the hungry children, homeless street people, poor families living in slums with nutritious cooked food. These people live with constant hunger as they cannot afford to manage a proper meal in a day. BASMAH team is reaching out to these people twice in every week right in front of their doors. These cooked foods prove to be of great help to these impoverished children and the poor that their smiles testify. In the month of September 2020, BASMAH has distributed food in various areas around Dhaka city including Mohammadpur, Vatara, Kamrangirchar, Gulistan, and Chankarpul slums.



BASMAH New Initiative in Sonargaon, Narayanganj



BASMAH has come forward to stand beside the disadvantaged people of Syedabad Island. Syedabad happens to be a remote Island in Narayanganj District which is surrounded by rivers & wetlands. Boat is the only mode of communication to reach the island. The people here are poor, deprived of basic services and live on fishing and manual labor. There is no school in this Island and children cannot go to school. BasmaH's new initiative aims to build a school here so that the children can get their right to education and look forward to brighter future. Basmah also aims to

provide medical care for the people here. BASMAH remains committed to help the island develop and provide better service to its people.
